Congratulations to the winners and participants and **THANK YOU** to all those who support and volunteer around our artists.

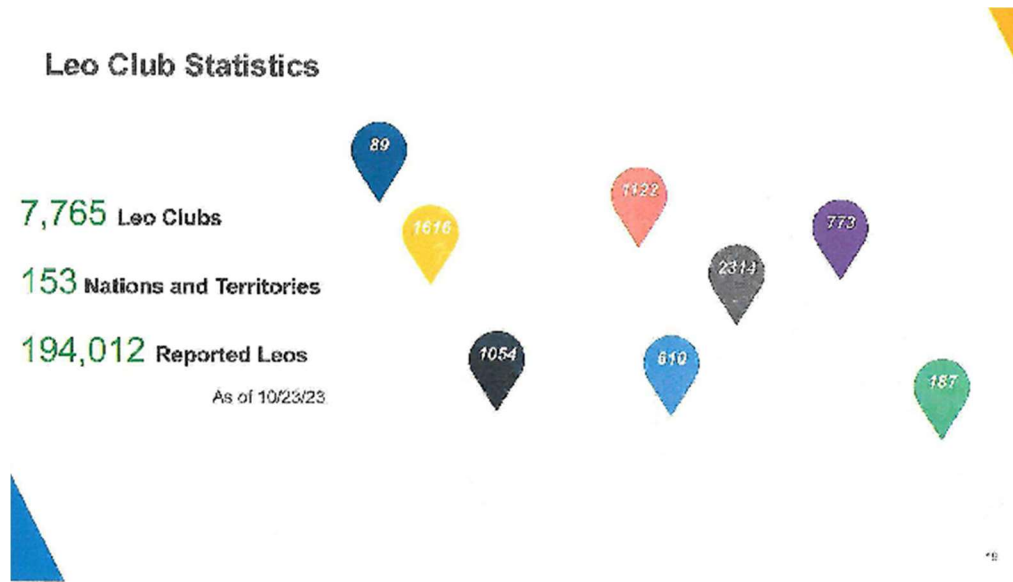
## AT OUR INTERNATIONAL LEOS

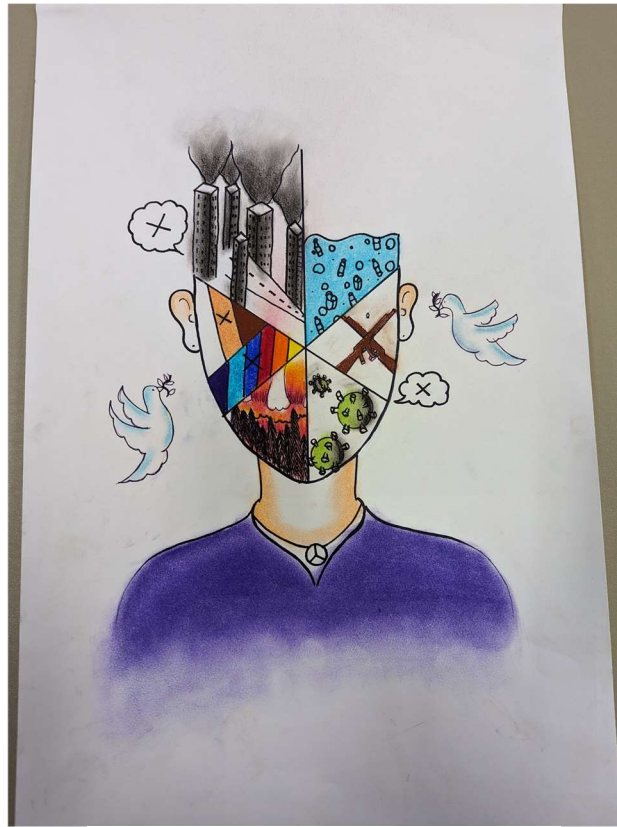
