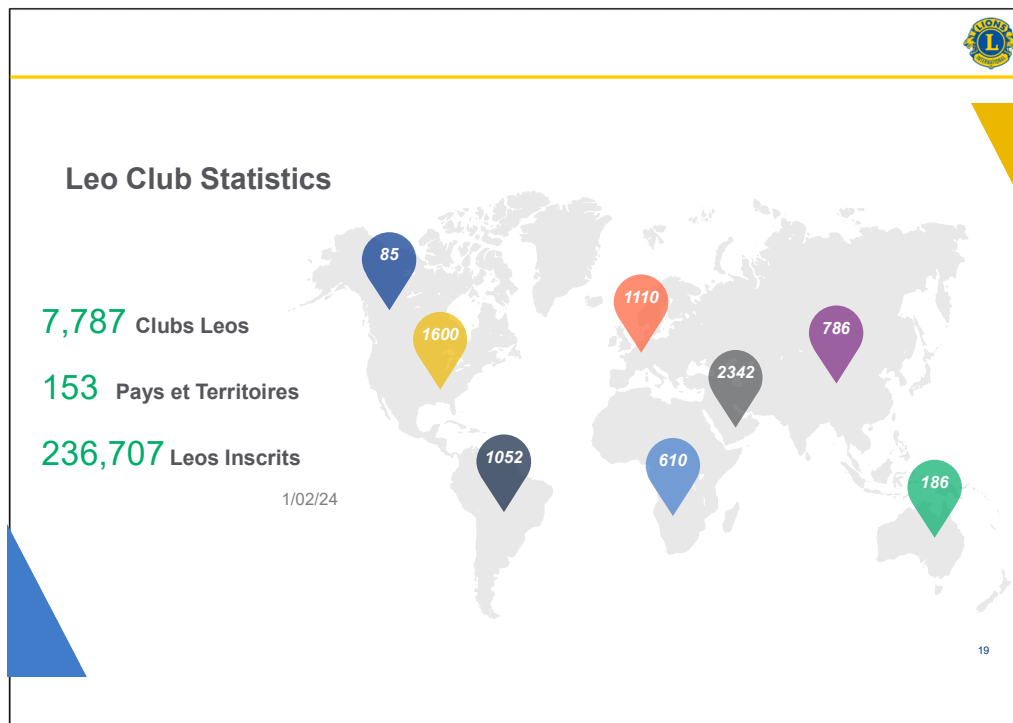
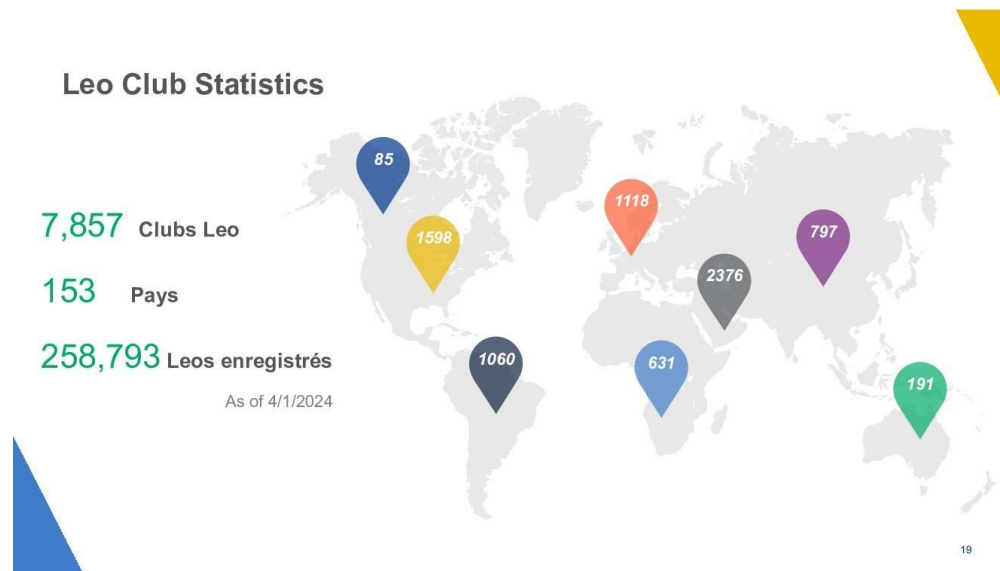

Members interacted with several residents.

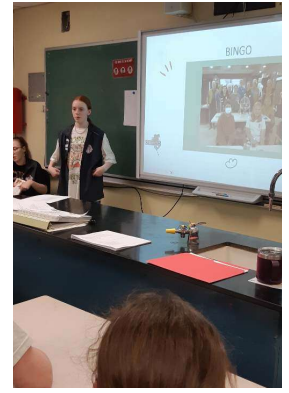


Leopard Club – Youth visit.

U-3 DISTRICT. CLUB LIONS AVENIR DE SAINT-PIERRE ET MIQUELON. Service for children 2023-2024. « The funny balls » project.

We had the pleasure of presenting in September 2023 in Saint-Pierre and then, in October in Miquelon, the "colorables" and "colorboards" of the "Drôles de bouilles".

An innovative, funny, educational and environmentally conscious concept because this is the end of paper.

Coloring tables to infinity; stories and characters that push to discover; games and learning workshops adapted from the Montessori method.

Their objectives: to promote inclusion, sharing, self-expression; to develop the fine motor skills, coordination and concentration of your children; to make them even more creative, autonomous, and to make them aware of the preservation of nature, flora, oceans, and ecosystems.

All these materials are suitable for children from 2 years old, certain pathologies, the development of imagination and vocabulary.

Around these tables, we talk about emotions, sharing, ecology, we play, we invent stories, we learn the fundamentals, and we sometimes set, and if necessary, landmarks.

15 of these tables and 7 paintings were given to the nursery schools of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon, to the speech therapy cabinets, the Accueil de Loisirs des jeunes enfants de Saint-Pierre, the Centre Hospitalier and the Ronald Mc Donald house in St John's TNL where many children from Saint-Pierre and Miquelon are welcomed when they have to go to Newfoundland for treatment.

All these small users were delighted with these donations!

A fundraiser was carried out for this purpose with the **Pencil and baluchon** project.

In June 2023, the members of the Club Lions de Sainte-Blandine made some students happy who have distinguished themselves on commitment and academic perseverance. Indeed, scholarships have been awarded to students finishing in grade 6 of primary and secondary school.

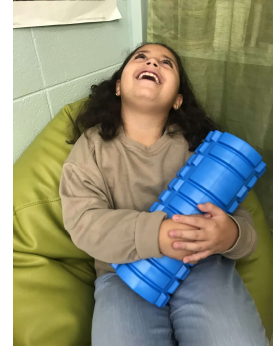
