In addition, they told sixth graders that a visit to their school was scheduled for May 2026 and that they could fill out a registration form.

Once again this year, the Leo Les Diamants club, supported by the Club Lions Québec-Diabète, took part, on September 26, in the "Community Engagement Fair" organized by the Armand-Corbeil School in Terrebonne. This event aims to integrate students into their community by providing them with the opportunity to explore their role and engage in actions based on principles such as community service. It facilitates the recruitment of young volunteers for local organizations and allows associations to make themselves known to students. This activity is part of the school's PEI program. This International Baccalaureate (IB) Intermediate Education Program aims to develop in young people an intellectual curiosity, knowledge and sensitivity that will allow them to contribute to the construction of a better and more peaceful world, in a spirit of mutual understanding and intercultural respect, values also promoted by the Club Lions Québec-Diabète and the club Léo Les Diamants. At this event, more than 50 young people expressed their interest in joining the LÉO club, encouraged by the presence of LÉO managers: Maya, president, Noorulain, treasurer, Margarita, secretary, Christian, marketing manager and with the support of Lion Robert Bacon, Leo advisor for the Les Diamants club. To date, the show has officially recruited 7 new members, and others should soon join them.

Following this event, the Leo les Diamants club organized its first members' meeting on October 6th. At this meeting, several committees were created to develop various service activities, including the Halloween committee, the toy collection committee, and the plush committee for the creation of a dog designed and made by young people with recycled fabrics. In addition, some members have signed up for direct volunteering, such as participation in the Guignolée.

The Club Lions Québec-Diabète would like to strongly highlight and applaud the creativity and commitment of these young LEO and wishes them well-deserved success in their project. They can always count on our support, although they already organize themselves very well on their own.
